Dear friends,

We now enter the Jubilee Year of the Eucharistic Youth Movement Jubilee leading us to the centenary celebration of the EYM in Rome in August 2015.

As you know EYM, known at that time as the "Eucharistic Crusade," was born in France (Bordeaux) in November 1915. It was born in the context of the European war of 1914-1918, following the Pope's appeal to children to pray for peace. EYM has grown rapidly around the world as the "youth branch" of the Apostleship of Prayer. You can learn all about it by reading the international document on the **history of MEJ** (Attached)

In EYM today there are over a million children and young people in 54 countries worldwide!

For 99 years now we have walked with Jesus in many countries and many cultures, our hearts filled with the Eucharist and the mission given us.

"Jubilee" comes from the Latin Jubilare, that is to say, "rejoice." A Jubilee year is a year of joy, a year of celebration, thanking the Lord for the gift he has given us. The theme of the Jubilee Year, and the meeting in Rome, comes from the Gospel of St. John, chap. 15, 11: "That my joy may be in you"

As we celebrate **Corpus Christi, the world day of our Movement**, we wish everyone a joyful feast. A great Jubilee Year to you all ! May it provide us with an opportunity to further deepen the spiritual way that the EYM offers us: the joy of being friends of Jesus, the source of the Eucharist, in the service of the mission of Christ in the Church.

May the Lord Jesus, the source of true joy, bless all of you and each EYM team serving both our children and our youth!
